Global Prayer — On zoom, in person, and through email, teams of people gather throughout the month to pray for Emmanuel Faith global workers, countries in crisis, and gospel movements. Email outreach@efcc.org to receive global prayer requests and meeting invites.

Global Worker Care and Housing Teams — Emmanuel Faith has 71 global workers and partners. Our Care Team helps them stay connected to the body here in Escondido by encouraging and praying for them, remembering birthdays and anniversaries, and hosting workers for meals when they are home on furlough. The Housing Team helps with maintenance and upkeep on the missionary condo as well as finding EFCC families who are willing to host global workers for a stay or a meal. Ministry to Refugees — Families and individuals from some of the hardest to reach places are moving into our communities as refugees and asylum seekers. Global Outreach: Disciple-Making in West Africa

Some of the people groups Emmanuel Faith has adopted this year are from the Francophone West Africa region. Despite political unrest and a long tradition of Islamic control, many West Africans are becoming disciples of Jesus. Here are two people groups to pray for:

Guerze of Guinea — Guinea is a republic on the west coast of Africa. The Guerze or Kpelle people are a minority group that primarily resides in the rain forest. They are traditional farmers and live in village-tribes. This past year nine new churches have been planted among the Guerze of Guinea!



Prayer needs:

- 1. Pray for the Guerze/Kpelle people to become devoted followers of Jesus.
- 2. Pray for more workers to make disciples and plant churches among these people.
- 3. Pray for the protection of church planters and their families.

Hassaniya of Niger — An Unreached and Unengaged People Group, the Hassaniya are 100 percent Muslim. This Arab people group is found in the desert regions of Niger. Their language traces back to the Bedouin tribes of North Africa. Through the grace of God we have started to see new churches among them. This past year, 34 new disciples of Jesus came from the Hassaniya people.



Prayer needs:

- 1. Pray for their accessibility, because they are difficult to reach geographically.
- 2. Pray for the training of disciples and trainers in the Arabic language.
- 3. Pray that they will have wells to provide water for their animals.
