



Bridge Builders Network: Local Refugee Ministry

In the past, cross-cultural ministry meant serving far away in other nations. Today, in San Diego especially, many who need to hear the gospel live in our

neighborhoods as refugees. Bridge Builders Network is called to engage in this specialized cross-cultural work. They help local San Diego churches enter in relationship with their refugee neighbors, providing tangible needs and creating opportunities for them to meet Jesus.



Currently, Bridge Builders (BBN) is meeting many Afghan refugees who have made their way to San Diego after fleeing immense danger and trauma. BBN helps Afghan men, women, and children acquire needed resources and skills to thrive in the US in a culturally — accessible way. Children attend Learning Bridge, a homework/tutoring ministry. Women enjoy meeting together and honing their sewing skills. Men have meals together and volunteers assist with job applications and driving lessons. Here is one story of a recent refugee from Afghanistan:

Ali fled for his life from the Taliban, making his way to Brazil and then to the USA. His only option was to leave his wife and two daughters behind in Afghanistan. BBN found him without money, friends, or a place to live and put him up in a hotel until he could find more permanent housing. Over several months Ali joined BBN programs and gatherings and learned about Jesus. He has quietly come to faith, now has a regular church home, and is growing in his faith. BBN continues to disciple Ali. He loves the freedom in the US and is already sharing his faith with his family back home. Please pray for Ali's family to be able to join him here in San Diego.
