Honesty is the bedrock of relationships, but deceit is one of our main self-protective mechanisms.

- Fear of losing control which results in manipulation.
- Fear of <u>disappointing others</u> which results in <u>people pleasing</u>.
- Fear of being known which results in image management.
- Fear of missing out which results in flakiness.

Deceit is incompatible with life in the **Kingdom of God**.

- 1. Say what **you mean**.
- 2. Do what **you say**.
- 3. Strive for **consistency**.

Never forget that **God** is the great **promise keeper**!
