

Understanding Church Funds and Ministries

General Fund – This is the primary operating fund of the church. Donations to this fund are unrestricted and are used to cover the day-to-day expenses of the church that are essential for ministry including all personnel costs, overhead costs, and all ministry expenses, including the Emmanuel Faith Preschool and Café. Donations earmarked for children and student ministry scholarships and events, such as the Harvest Party, are also captured in this fund. This fund is essential to allow the church to carry out its mission and programs.

Donations to the following funds are restricted. Donations directed to any of these funds must legally be used by the church within the context and intent of each fund's purpose. Money cannot be freely transferred between restricted funds:

Outreach Fund – This fund is dedicated to activities and initiatives that extend the church's mission beyond our congregation. It is used regularly to cover the cost of missionary support, and may also be used to support evangelism efforts, community service projects, strategic partnerships with other ministries, or supporting projects in the community and around the world.

Care Fund – This fund, previously called the Fellowship Fund, is designated for helping individuals or families within our church family who are experiencing financial hardship or emergencies. It may cover things like medical expenses, living expenses, counseling expenses, food assistance, or other urgent needs. The intent of this fund is to offer compassion and support to those in difficult circumstances, reflecting the church's commitment to caring for its church family. Currently, the Care Fund has a healthy balance to support its purpose.

Beyond Fund – This fund is dedicated to paying down the Beyond Loan Balance for the church's property and campus. Over the past seven years, several essential updates and improvements have been made, including the construction of the Children's Center, improvements to existing buildings, and addressing long-term facility needs. These projects are critical to ensuring the church remains a safe, functional, and welcoming space for worship, ministry programs, and community activities.

The average monthly payment on the loan ranges from \$50,000 to \$55,000, with a remaining balance due of \$7.4 million dollars. Our goal is to receive enough donations to the Beyond Fund each month to cover these payments, helping us move closer to becoming debt-free. We encourage those who are able to give above and beyond their regular giving so we can pay off the loan more quickly and free up resources for future ministry opportunities.

While these funds have distinct purposes, all donations to Emmanuel Faith Church are tax-deductible.
