The Challenge: Since the Bible is "God-breathed," **continue to trust and follow** its principles in decision-making. (John 8:31-32)

Because ...

- 1. They have a **proven track record**. (3:14; Psa. 12:6; Heb. 13:7)
- 2. They're the **source of godly wisdom**. (3:15)

The Point: The Bible's wisdom gives us **God's** opinion on matters, not **humanity's** opinion. (Ex. 20:15; Matt. 22:39; 1 Thess. 4:3)

- 3. They're the best **tool** for **spiritual formation**. (3:16; 1 Pet. 2:2; Psa. 19:9)
- 4. They prepare us for the **challenges ahead**. (3:17; James 1:25; Rom. 15:4; Josh. 1:8)
